
FOUNDATION OF IVR



- 1874 by German and Swiss insurance companies in Frankfurt am Main as "Rheinschiffsregisterverband"
- to inspect in addition to the statutory inspection based on the Mannheim Act – all insurable inland navigation vessels in respect of their fitness and
- enter the vessels that were found fit into a register the first IVR-Register was published in 1879




NEWLY BUILT VESSELS BY TYPE OF USE 2007 -2017


