Member States Germany, Belgium, France, the Netherlands, and Switzerland

PRINCIPLE OF FREE NAVIGATION ON THE RHINE AND ITS TRIBUTARIES

- in application of Article 3 of the Mannheim Convention, the Member States must refrain from imposing any toll, tax, duty or charge based directly on the fact of navigation
- additional agreement to the Mannheim Document was adopted on 16 May 1952 on the Customs and tax scheme for diesel oil consumed as fuel by vessels using the Rhine.
